

GED Vocabulary

GED Vocabulary enables students preparing for the GED test to learn the key vocabulary words for all High School Equivalency Tests, including the GED.

The Words

GED Vocabulary is based on a database of over 2,000 words. For each word, there is a definition, a context sentence, a misspelling, and an audio file. The database includes the most important words students taking HSE tests need to know and understand. The words cover the five HSE subjects: (1) Reading, (2) Writing, (3) Math, (4) Science, and (5) Social Studies.

The Activities

Students learn and practice the Vocabulary words using a variety of Flink Learning games:

Student Control
